12	AOB	Joyce Collett asked if there could be clear marking of car parking spaces available to DARC members because of the reduced number of spaces.  Joyce also asked that the club purchase lockers which may be used by individual members on a more permanent basis as Tyne Utd. This had already been discussed at management meetings after Joyce requested previously.  The weeds in the river were discussed. PR asked if Nick Baird would get a team together to help with this problem.  The Dredging of the river was discussed. Richard Mortimer informed the members that the cost would be approx. £100K.  George Adair suggested that people be more vocal in the media to try to get help with this problem.
