#### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Entries close 19.00 Saturday 2nd November 2019 or earlier if the safety limit is exceeded.
- 2. Entry fees are £8.00 per seat, coxes are free. Payment by BROE2 Only.
- 3. The organisers retain the right to accept and reject entries for any reason.
- 4. Entries should be paid by close of entry.
- 5. Times will be combined across the two divisions and no account will be taken for changes in conditions between divisions. No competitor can enter the same event in both divisions but can enter in different bands where applicable.
- 6. Visiting clubs may double up in both divisions but in the event of the entry limit being exceeded only one entry may be accept ed.
- 7. The event will take place late morning / afternoon after Durham Long Distance Sculls
- 8. Please state if you are NOT prepared to row at a higher status / age group. Masters Handicap system will be applied as required.
- 9. INSURANCE: Note that your BR membership insurance is only valid for UK residents who are resident in this country for more than six months in a year. Evidence of insurance cover must be provided by those not covered by BR membership insurance.
- 10. The draw will take place on Monday 4th November at Durham ARC.
- 11. The draw and safety instructions will be posted on <a href="https://www.durham-arc.org.uk">www.durham-arc.org.uk</a> on or after Tuesday 5th November.
- 12. All boats must have a slot for taking plastic numbers on the bow.
- 13. Glass goblet prizes will be awarded in events with three or more crews racing.
- 14. In the event of cancellation 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
