### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Entries close 18.00 Thursday 2nd May.
- 2. Entry fees are £8.00 per seat (coxes are free). Payment by BROE2 Only.
- 3. Doubling up is permitted between divisions. No doubling up of crew or equipment within a division.
- 4. Times of divisions are approximate and are subject to change depending on entries.
- 5. Please state if you are NOT prepared to row at a higher status / age group.
- 6. Masters events may be split by age using BR handicap.
- 7. Senior events in 1x, 2, 4x- & 4x+ may be banded by ranking points depending on entries
- 8. In Senior 8+ and 4+ events we are offering Novice and Senior, this is primarily aimed at easing problems with boat sharing for clubs, offered in different divisions. Novice crews will be those with fewer than 50 ranking points for a 4+ or 100 points for an 8+. Senior crews may be banded by ranking points depending on entries.
- 9. J13 Events must use macon / bantum sculls.
- 10. Spot checks will be made on crew identities and racing licences.
- 11. All coxes must be weighed in at control prior to their first race.
- 12. INSURANCE: Note that your BR membership insurance is only valid for UK residents who are resident in this country for more than six months in a year. Evidence of insurance cover must be provided by those not covered by BR membership insurance.
- 13. We reserve the right to reject crews for any reason in the event of oversubscription.
- 14. The draw will take place on Saturday 4th May & Sunday 5th May at Durham ARC.
- **15.** The draw and safety instructions will be posted on <u>www.durham-arc.org.uk</u> on or after Tuesday 7th May.
- 16. In the event of cancellation 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
