### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Entries close 19.00 Friday 26th January 2018
- 2. Entry fees are £8.00 per seat, coxes are free. Payment by BROE2 Only.
- 3. The first 100 completed will be taken for each division, entries should be paid by 18:00 Monday 29th January once they have been accepted.
- 4. Times will be combined across the four divisions and no account will be taken for changes in conditions between divisions.
- 5. No one competitor can enter the same event more than once.
- 6. Please state if you are NOT prepared to row at a higher status / age group. Masters Handicap system will be applied as required.
- 7. INSURANCE: Note that your BR membership insurance is only valid for UK residents who are resident in this country for more than six months in a year. Evidence of insurance cover must be provided by those not covered by BR membership insurance.
- 8. The draw will take place on Sunday 28th January at Durham ARC.
- 9. The draw and safety instructions will be posted on <a href="www.durham-arc.org.uk">www.durham-arc.org.uk</a> on or after Tuesday 30th January.
- 10. Boating times will be published in advance, time penalties will be incurred for missing your boating slot.
- 11. All boats must have a slot for taking plastic numbers on the bow.
- 12. All coxes must weigh in.
- 13. Glass goblet prizes will be awarded in events with three or more crews racing.
- 14. In the event of cancellation 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
