Event 1 – Durham College Rowing Challenge 8's

Offered for Open and Women's crews at Novice and Senior Level

Event 2 – Durham City Scratch Eights

Mixed crews drawn at random from all clubs - J16 and above

Event 3 – Durham City Scratch Quads

Mixed crews drawn at random from all clubs - J15 and below

Arrival / registration for all events from 9am, Racing to start at 10am

Other fundraising events including ergo challenges and Dragon Boating will be available on the day.

Entry Information – Sunday 10th May

- Entry fees are £5 per seat **including** coxes all profits to GNAA.
- Only one entry per college in each of the 4 college events.
- Prizes will be awarded for the winner of each event.
- All crews in Events 2 & 3 guaranteed 2 races.
- Eights event may be split into fours depending on entries.
- Boats for events 2 & 3 will be provided.
- All competitors must hold a BR racing licence.

How to Enter

- Entries for Event 1 can be made by email to the regatta secretary <u>regattasec@durham-arc.org.uk</u> by 6pm on Friday 1st May.
- Entries for events 2 & 3 should be submitted to regatta control by noon on Saturday 9th May specifying name, sex and preference for bowside / strokside / cox. It would help if more than 10 members from a visiting club intend to enter the scratch event that we are warned in advance to help plan / borrow boats.
- The draw will take place on Saturday 9th May and be published in the boathouse on Sunday morning.
